## **Leaf Collection Now in Full Swing**

*Program to run through December 4*

(New Albany, Ohio) The 2009 leaf collection season in New Albany will run from Monday, October 12, to Friday, December 4.

During this time, leaves will be collected every week by the New Albany Public Service Department but not through every neighborhood. The following is a breakdown of the the department's scheduled weekly pass-through, depending upon location:

<i>October 12-16</i>	<i>Village-wide "First Sweep" through all neighborhoods</i>
<i>October 19-23</i>	<i>Sweep of neighborhoods SOUTH of Dublin-Granville Road</i>
<i>October 26-30</i>	<i>Sweep of neighborhoods NORTH of Dublin-Granville Road</i>
<i>November 2-6</i>	<i>Sweep of neighborhoods SOUTH of Dublin-Granville Road</i>
<i>November 9-13</i>	<i>Sweep of neighborhoods NORTH of Dublin-Granville Road</i>
<i>November 16-20</i>	<i>Sweep of neighborhoods SOUTH of Dublin-Granville Road</i>
<i>November 23-27</i>	<i>Sweep of neighborhoods NORTH of Dublin-Granville Road</i>
<i>Nov. 30-Dec. 4</i>	<i>Village-wide "Final Sweep" through all neighborhoods</i>

Residents are asked to rake leaves to the edge of the roadway, or back of curb, but not the street. Please avoid placing leaves near mailboxes, trees, lights or signs whenever possible, and please only place leaves in the leaf piles. Branches, twigs and grass clippings are not to be placed with leaves for collection.

To ensure collection, leaves are to be placed at the curb before 7:00 a.m. on the Monday of each collection period. If this is not possible, leaves placed in a paper yard waste bag or in a container marked "yard waste" can be left with Thursday curbside yard waste collection.
