



## 2010 New Albany Road Construction Projects

US 62/Central College: This project, in excess of \$2 million, will reduce the number of accidents at this intersection (there were 40 accidents at this intersection during the last four years. Much of the work was completed in 2009, but traffic signals were installed and activated earlier this year. Final paving is scheduled the week of May 10<sup>th</sup>. **Estimated completion: May 2010**

Cedar Brook Area Improvements: Five streets in this subdivision will be repaved, including Cedar Brook Drive, Cedar Brook Glen, Cedar Brook Place, Cedar Glen Court, and Doran Drive. Work is scheduled for May. Residents will be notified when their individual streets will be repaved. Residents will have access in and out of their neighborhoods and driveways during this work, but there may be momentary delays. **Estimated completion: Late May 2010**

US 62 Right Turn Lane Widening Project (Zarley to Smith's Mill): Construction activity began the week of April 12. No road or intersection closures will take place for this work, but lanes may be narrowed for paving and construction activity. **Estimated completion: Late May 2010**

SR 161 & US 62 Lane Improvements: This \$90,000 project includes a left turn lane for the SR 161 east bound exit ramp at US 62, and a dedicated right turn lane to be constructed on US 62 north bound at the Smith's Mill Road intersection. **Estimated completion: June 2010**

SR 605 @ Walton Parkway: This \$500,000 project funded through a federal stimulus grant includes a traffic signal at this intersection and 2,500 lineal feet of new asphalt on SR 605. This signal will improve traffic flow in the business park. **Estimated completion: July 2010**

Miller Road and Third Street Resurfacing: Pending funding, these Village Center area roads will be repaved; total cost is \$170,000. **Estimated completion: Autumn 2010**

Bevelhymer Resurfacing: This \$120,000 repaving from Central College to Walton Parkway will occur later in 2010. **Estimated completion: Autumn 2010**

Leisure Trails: Trail expansions include a portion on SR 605 from Central College to Snyder Loop (\$170,000) and a portion on Central College from SR 605 to Wentworth Lane pending resident approval (\$200,000). Other trail improvements totaling \$100,000 include mid-block pedestrian crossings on SR 605 (near Windsor) and on Dublin-Granville near the McCoy Center. **Estimated completion: Autumn 2010**

County Projects that May Impact New Albany Motorists: Roundabout construction at the Morse/Reynoldsburg-New Albany intersection begins in May 2010; The Dublin-Granville bridge over Sugar Run is expected to be closed from July – October 2010.
