## **Village of New Albany Celebrates Arbor Day with Joint Partnership by Planting 200 Trees.**

*Planting to take place April 16<sup>th</sup>*

(New Albany, Ohio) The Village of New Albany Public Service Department, in conjunction with the New Albany Plain Local School District and Limited Brands, will plant more than 200 seedlings within the school's 3.5 acre Children's Nature Park adjacent to the playground of the K-1 Elementary Building on the school campus.
